Directions to Class

From I-84/Westbound:

Take exit 48, Asylum Street. From the exit ramp, take right onto Garden Street. At the second traffic light, take a left onto Collins Street. Follow for six blocks. At the light, take a right onto Woodland Street. Go through the light at Ashley Street and turn right into the first driveway past the Innovation + Learning Center for the Urban League Parking lot. **(Please use caution when entering the lot, it is a tight turn.)** Drive around the building and park in the larger lot.

From I-84/Eastbound:

Take Exit 46, Sisson Avenue (a left exit). From the exit ramp, take right onto Sisson Avenue for four blocks. At the traffic light, take a right onto Farmington Avenue for four blocks. Take a left onto Woodland Street and continue straight ahead, passing Saint Francis Hospital and Medical Center on the right. Go through the light at Ashley Street and turn right into the first driveway past the Innovation + Learning Center for the Urban League Parking lot. **(Please use caution when entering the lot, it is a tight turn.)** Drive around the building and park in the larger lot.

From I-91/Northbound:

Take Exit 32-A to I-84/Westbound. Follow directions above for I-84/Westbound.

From I-91/Southbound:

Take Exit 32-A to I-84/Westbound. Follow directions above for I-84/Westbound.

Once off the interstate highway, the routes are clearly marked with blue and white trailblazer signs displaying an “H”, the universal symbol for the hospital.
